VPN Instructions

Only those who are allowed access will get access. Also we have setup a firewall. If you want remote access you have to follow these directions explicitly. You will need a Civil account.

Graduate and PHD Students will be able to use the Remote Access during the following times <u>ONLY</u>

Monday to Friday 5pm to 8am

Saturday and Sunday All times until 8am following Monday

Graduate computers are named the following:

Grad01 to Grad30

Remember to add domain info when using Remote Desktop.

Grad01.sociveng.ryerson.ca

This VPN will allow remote desktop to ALL graduate computers.

Or their ip address.

Note:

If you do not logoff or disconnect your remote session you will be forced off by anyone who wants to use that machine the following day after 8 am.(Reboot) If you are in the labs between the hours of 5pm and 8 am during the week and on weekends please respect your fellow students. Do not force a remote logoff or reboot the machine. Go to a machine that is not in use. The same applies for remote connections. If someone is logged in please respect that, do not login. Also please respect any documentation place on a workstation.

Click on the small computer, icon located on the taskbar just left of the clock. A window will pop up, in that window click on "Open Network and Sharing Center".



Then click on "Set up a new connection or network".



Click "Connect to a workplace", then click on "Next".
